As to the Removal of *Susan M^o Nowall the Widow of Samuel Henry
M^o Nowall and her four lawful Children by her said late
Husband M^o Henry aged Eleven Years Emma aged Eight years Samuel aged
Five Years and did Months, and James aged Three Years and nine Months.*
To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of *Woburn Bishops*,
in the County of *Bucks*.

Take Notice, That the above named *Susan M^o Nowall*
now residing at *N^o 5, Fishers Row, Tamers Hill* in this Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford,
has with her said *four Children*
become and are now chargeable to the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, and are now receiving
Relief from the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, and that an Order of one of the Magistrates
of the Police Courts of the Metropolis, sitting at the Police Court at Greenwich, within the
Metropolitan Police District, and in the said County of Kent, has been obtained for their
removal to your Parish of *Woburn Bishops* as their
last place of legal Settlement, (a Duplicate of which Order is herewith sent)

And **Take Notice**, that the following are the grounds of the said Removal, and the
Particulars of the Settlement relied upon by us in support thereof:

For that the said *Susan M^o Nowall* with her said *four Children*
have come to inhabit, and are now inhabiting in the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford.

And for that the said *Susan M^o Nowall* and her said
four Children
before and at the time of the making of the said Order of Removal were and are now
residing in and receiving Relief from, and were then and are now actually chargeable to, the said
Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, not having resided in the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford,

for five years next before the Application for the said Order, and not having gained a legal
Settlement in the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, nor having produced any Certificate
acknowledging them to be settled elsewhere; nor having become chargeable to the said Parish of
Saint Paul, Deptford, in respect of Relief made necessary by Sickness or Accident, and not being
otherwise by law exempt from being removed from the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford.

And for that the said *Susan M^o Nowall* was married to her late
Husband *Samuel Henry M^o Nowall* at the Parish Church
of Bromley in the said County of Kent on the Twenty
Ninth day of January One thousand Eight hundred and
Forty Four and has by him *four lawful Children* (viz)
the *four Children* whose names and ages are above set
forth.

And for that the said *Samuel Henry M^o Nowall*
departed this Life at Little Brickhill near Leighton Buzzard,
in the said County of Bucks, on the Twenty Sixth day of
April the thousand Eight hundred and Fifty Five.

And for that the said *Samuel Henry M^o Nowall* was a
Native of Belfast in Ireland and never did any Act to
acquire a legal Settlement in England.

And for that the said Susan M^{rs} Donnell is the
lawful daughter of John Dandridge by Susannah
his Wife and was born on the Twenty Third day
of September One thousand Eight hundred and Nineteen
in a Cottage which was built by the said John
Dandridge and was situate at a place called
Northern Woods in your said Parish of Woburn Bishops
and has never either before her Marriage or since
her said Husband's Decease done any act to acquire
a legal Settlement.

And for that the said John Dandridge
the said Father of the said Susan M^{rs} Donnell
about Twenty Five years ago at the time of his
being transported beyond seas for Machine Breaking
had a derivative Settlement in your said Parish
of Woburn Bishops by reason of his Father John
Dandridge being then and having been for several
years prior to the Emancipation of the said John
Dandridge the Owner of a Freehold Estate situate
at Northern Woods aforesaid in your said Parish
of Woburn Bishops (on part of which Estate the
said John Dandridge built the Cottage wherein
his said daughter Susan M^{rs} Donnell was born)
and for several years before the Emancipation of his said son
having resided on his said Freehold Estate in your said
Parish of Woburn Bishops.

And Take Notice, That unless Notice of Appeal against the said Order be received by us
within Twenty-one Days from the sending hereof, or (in case of your application for a Copy of the
Depositions on which such Order has been made) within a further period of Fourteen Days after
the sending of such Copy, the said Pauper s will be removed to your said Parish of Woburn
Bishops in pursuance of the said Order, and no Appeal
against such Order shall afterwards be allowed.

Whereas Complaint hath been made unto me *James Fraill* Esquire, whose Hand is hereunto set and Seal affixed, being one of the Magistrates of the Police Courts of the Metropolis, sitting at the Police Court at Greenwich, in the said County of Kent, and in the said Metropolitan Police District, by the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, that *Susan M^e Dowall the widow of Anne Henry M^e Dowall and her four lawful Children by her said late Husband, that is to say Henry aged Eleven years, Emma aged Eight years, Samuel aged Five years and Six Months, and James aged Three years and Nine Months*

have come to inhabit, and *she* now inhabiting in the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, not having resided in the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford,

for five years next before the said Complaint, and the application for this Warrant, and not having gained a legal Settlement there, nor having produced any Certificate acknowledging *them* to be settled elsewhere, and that *they* *are* now actually chargeable to the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, and *she* now receiving Relief therefrom; and that such Relief is Relief which has been made necessary otherwise than by sickness or accident; and that the said *Parish* of *Woburn Bishops* is the place of *their* last legal Settlement: *£*, the said Magistrate, upon due proof thereof, as well by Examination of Witnesses, upon Oath, as otherwise, and upon due consideration of the Premises, do adjudge the same to be true, and I do also adjudge that the Place of the last legal Settlement of the said

Susan M^e Dowall and her said four Children

is in the said *Parish* of *Woburn Bishops*, in the said County of *Bucks*.

These are therefore in Her Majesty's Name, to require and Order you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, or some or one of you, or some proper person or persons to be authorized and employed by you, at such time and in such manner as by Law is provided and directed in that behalf, to remove and convey the said

Susan M^e Dowall and her said four Children

from and out of your said Parish of Saint Paul, Deptford, to the said *Parish* of *Woburn Bishops* and *them* deliver, together with this my Order or a Duplicate or true copy thereof, unto the Overseers of the Poor there, or one of them, who are hereby required to receive and provide for *them* according to Law.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the said Police Court at Greenwich, in the said County of Kent, and in the said Metropolitan Police District, this *second* Day of *June* in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty *Six*.
